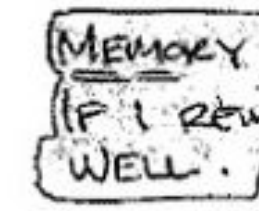

Stair Section Installation

- See complete instructions on Fiber Composites' Web Site: www.fibercomposites.com.
- Position two line posts at top of stairway with the desired spacing and secure each post with the appropriate bracket.

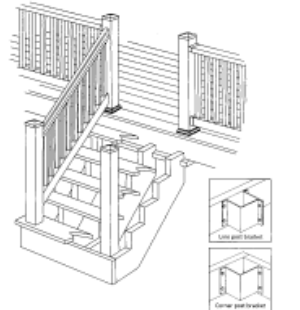
Note: The stair angle should be prepared for a 32 degree angle which is equal to a 7" rise and an 11" run.
- Install the outside stair stringers just wider than the posts' location. The posts mounted at the bottom of the stairs will be on the inside of the stringer and will line up directly with the posts at the top of the stairs.
- Install each post at the bottom of each stair, using a full line bracket configuration.

Note: In the case of a multiple stair section stair descent, use an angular distance between the posts of no greater than 72".

Ensure each post is plumb and true prior to final mounting.
- After mounting the post bracket inside the stringers,
 - To properly support the stair treads, mount a parallel set of stringers inside each stair post no more than 1" away. OR
 - Construct a secured box around each post location. (Installer: Plan for this condition prior to beginning installation.)
- Measure the distance between installed posts at various points. Ensure that all distances are within 1/16".

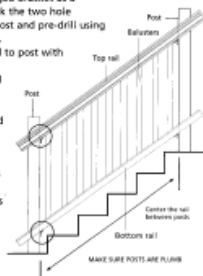
Note: This ensures posts are parallel and plumb.
- Lay bottom rail on stair with marked end (measuring approx. 4-1/2" from rail's end to first baluster hole) at lower post. Mark angles on rail.

Note: Remember to trim equally on both ends of each rail to ensure that balusters are uniformly spaced at each end and plumb. Do not leave an open baluster mount hole at the bracket position. To allow for the hinged bracket, leave a minimum of 2" between each end of the top rail and the edge of the first baluster hole.
- Line up top rail baluster holes with bottom rail baluster holes, marked ends together. (Top rail reference end will be approx. 2-1/2" from first baluster hole.)
- Cut both bottom and top rails with the same angle.
- Ensure that cut rails fit tightly between posts.
- Center hinged bracket on underside of bottom rail. Inset bracket 1/16" from rail's end.
- Using hinged bracket as a template, mark the three hole locations on bottom rail and pre-drill using a 1/8" drill bit.
- Repeat steps 11 & 12 for top rail.
- Screw the bracket to the bottom rail using three screws. Repeat on opposite end.
- Repeat step 14 for top rail.



- Center bottom rail on post and swing lower hinge onto post.

Note: Bottom rail should not rest on front edge of stair tread. (A 1/4" space is sufficient.)
- Using the hinged bracket as a template, mark the two hole locations on post and pre-drill using a 1/8" drill bit.
- Secure bottom rail to post with 2 screws.
- Insert pointed ends of angle-cut balusters into pre-routed holes on bottom rail.
- Place top rail onto balusters, using a slight slope, capturing one baluster at a time.
- Center the top rail on each post and swing lower hinge onto post.
- Using the hinged bracket as a template, mark the two hole locations on post and pre-drill using a 1/8" drill bit.
- Secure top rail to post with 2 screws.
- Ensure that all hinged brackets are fully tightened yet not over-tightened. Mount and glue post caps on posts after all rail sections are in place.
- Repeat steps 11 & 12 for top rail.
